Safety is a priority for the FIA. Since the launch of the Mygale Formula 4 in 2014, F3 standards and the latests developments in Formula 1 are integrates on the F4 (low nose, carbon rear crash boxes, protection of the driver's head, wheel tethers and extractable seat).

2017 marks a real step forward because a new kit of 3 elements is being introduced to further improve the safety of the driver :

- The head restraint is now reinforced with foam to offer better head protection in the case of lateral impact,
- A more enveloping extractable seat to the latest FIA safety standards is being fitted,
- The wheel tether strength is being increased from 4Kj to 6Kj.

The Mygale F4 car is now being used in Championships in Australia, China, Mexico, South East Asia, UK and, from April this year in a new Championship in Denmark.
