30 years have passed without a single Mexican driver in Formula 1. *Sergio Pérez* never wants that to happen again. He is pleased that today the FIA Formula 4 Mygale opens the doors to more drivers in order to enable them to reach more easily the F1 and thus that Mexico was always represented.

After 3 laps, *Sergio Pérez*, gets out of the car and feels happy. He finds that the FIA Formula 4 Mygale is really comfortable to drive. The young pilot of Force India is convinced that this new category will develop and encourage the future generation of Mexican drivers for the future.

The first race of the Mexican FIA Formula 4 Mygale Championship will start in Mexico on 1st November 2015 during the Formula 1 Grand Prix.
